Technical Information

A powerful alkaline detergent specifically designed to ease the removal of Flexisperse CW-40 from coated surfaces. To remove Flexisperse CW-40 coatings, liberally spray an 8 % solution of Flexiclean CWR on the coating, wait 10 to 15 minutes (but do not allow the surface to dry) then pressure wash off. Repeat as needed depending on thickness of coating and substrate porosity.

In addition to removing Flexisperse CW-40, this product is an excellent building block for many other user-friendly alkaline cleaners. Although Flexiclean CWR is high in alkalinity, it is mild to aluminum. However, prolonged exposure to polished aluminum may dull the finish and as such should be tested in an inconspicuous place before use.
